### Mohamed Ibn Chambas calls on Guinean actors to pursue political dialogue

**Conakry, 27 June 2015** – The Special Representative of the United Nations Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Office for West Africa (UNOWA), Mohamed Ibn Chambas, is closely following the ongoing political dialogue in Guinea.

Mr. Ibn Chambas recalls the commitment of the international community in general and the United Nations in particular to constructive dialogue in resolving political disputes.

He calls on political actors in Guinea to pursue the dialogue in order to find consensual solutions which are critical to inclusive, credible and peaceful elections.

Mohamed Ibn Chambas is currently in Conakry to continue his consultations with the various stakeholders involved in this dialogue process.

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General reaffirms the commitment of the United Nations and the international community to continuing to support Guinea in its efforts to hold inclusive elections under the conditions of transparency, security and serenity essential for their credibility.
