Fast Facts - Uniformed Personnel

In its **Resolution 2227** (29 June 2014), the Security Council authorized 11,240 military personnel and 1,440 police personnel for MINUSMA until 30 June 2016.



MANDATE

- **Support**, monitor and supervise the implementation of the **ceasefire** arrangements and confidence-building measures by the Government of Mali, the Platforme and Coordination armed groups.
- **Protect**, without prejudice to the primary responsibility of the Malian authorities, **civilians** under imminent threat of physical violence.
- In **support** of the Malian authorities, **stabilize the key population centres** and other areas where civilians are at risk, notably in the North of Mali.
- **Support the cantonment, disarmament, demobilization and reintegration** of armed groups, as well as the progressive redeployment of the Malian Defence and Security Forces especially in the North of Mali.

26,651 military patrols and **16,729** police patrols to deter threats and protect civilians

8,180 members of the Malian security forces trained by UN Police


